The focus of this conference is the **Henry Z. ("Hank") Jones Jr. Palatine Research Center**. Hank Jones will join us via live video to introduce the collection. Thomas Shannon, Vice President of the NY Chapter and Town Historian of Germantown will speak about the specifics of the collection and plans for making it accessible. Attendees will be able to view the collection firsthand. There will then be a lecture about the Palatine Germans who are buried at the Cheviot, First Reformed and First Lutheran cemeteries located in the early Palatine settlement areas of Germantown. Weather permitting, we will have a field trip to Cheviot Cemetery where Christopher White, NY Chapter Programs Chair will do a live gravestone cleaning workshop. Following the meeting, attendees are encouraged to utilize the great collection of Palatine German genealogical materials at the library.
